- SCENE 1 - LARRY'S REMOTE -

The scene opens with the Teacher in his classroom (*side stage*) two hours early preparing for his first day of teaching. He straightens up the empty room and practices addressing the class.

TOM

(sternly) Good morning class, I'm your new teacher- Mr.no that's no good... (more relaxed) Hi students, I'm Tom...NO! That's not right either. Uugghh! I don't know why I am so nervous this morning.

CUSTODIAN

(stands in doorway)

First day jitters, huh? Yep. I see it every year with the new teachers. Should I be tough? If I am too tough they will turn against me. Should I be nice? If I am too nice they won't respect me or pay attention. How will I ever get through to them?

TOM

That's exactly how I feel! By the way, my name is Tom.

CUSTODIAN

Yes, I know. I'm the one who put your name on the door. I'm Larry. Nice to meet you, Tom.

You see, you may have all the book knowledge on a subject, but if you can't find a way to get through to the students it's worthless. You have to find a way to make learning fun. If they enjoy a subject the learning is sure to follow.

TOM

Make it fun. That sounds so difficult though. How do you make math fun? Or history for that matter. At least with science you can blow stuff up. I don't know if I can do this. And all of the teachers here are so good. That just adds to the pressure.

CUSTODIAN

Just remember, they all started the very same way.

I may seem like just a custodian, but believe me, I see everything and know more about this school than most of the teachers. Which reminds me – had a feeling that you would be stressing over your first day, so I brought in a special television for you. It may calm you down a bit before the day gets going.

TOM

A television? I'm sure I don't have time for that. I have charts and workbooks to get ready to hand out. Rubrics, lesson outlines, details, details,...

CUSTODIAN

Trust me. A few minutes will do you good. Its worked so far for every single new teacher we've had here. And believe me, they **all** sounded just like you when they started.

The TV uses a very special remote with some added features...you'll find it on your desk.

(he disappears while Tom's back is turned)

TOM

Well, if I get a chance I'll...

(Tom realizes Larry has already gone)

hmm...oh well.

(Tom walks past the TV...pauses...sets the worksheets on his desk...looks around as if trying not to get caught...examines the oversized remote and then switches on the television...white noise only. The overhead lights flicker...strobes...sparks. Tom disappears from the side-stage. He screams as if he were falling as the lighting chaos continues. The main curtain opens with Tom standing inside a giant television, miming to the 'glass screen'.)

What's going on??? Where am I??

CUSTODIAN

(returns to classroom – addresses Tom's in the TV mainstage)
Ahh. I see you found the remote and took my advice.

TOM

What happened?? What did you do to me?

CUSTODIAN

I know this is hard for you to understand right now, but you are in TV Land. You are there for your own good as well as for the good of your students. Look around and soon you will see why you are there. Keep that remote handy for it is your ticket home, but only when you are truly ready.

Good luck....

(he leaves)

- Scene 2 - Tom's TV Guide -

TOM

Good luck??? Come back here. Bring me back now! Larry? Anyone?

(Tom looks at the remote and clicks it as he steps from behind the screen)

So you are supposed to get me back home. How does this work? I guess I click you 3 times.

There's no place like home. (click) There's no place like home. (click) There's no place like home. (click)

(the channel changes...white noise...and then...)

TV VOICES (24 - JACK BAUER)

This is Jack Bauer. I have the terrorist in sight. Open fire! (gun-shot noises)

TOM

No! Wait! I'm just a teacher! Don't shoot (click)

TV VOICES (Apprentice - DONALD TRUMP)

Tom, I'm very disappointed that it is taking you so long to figure out what's going on. Your weak Tom and I can't have weak individuals working for me. We've got to make teaching Great again! Maybe soon you'll discover what it takes to be a great teacher, but until that time I have to say, Tom, you're fired! (click)

TV VOICES (Sponge Bob - SPONGE BOB)

(theme song finishes)

Whoa! You're not Patrick. You're that teacher – Tom. What are you doing here? You're in the wrong channel. Come with me and I'll get you to the right place?

(rushes him across stage)
Here we go.

TV VOICES (School House Rock - ALL SHR CHARACTERS)

(School House Rock theme begins to play – SHR characters come out singing along)
Hello Tom. Welcome to School House Rock!
(introductions – Rocky, Zero, Janet, Morton, Pearl, Franklin, Molly)

ROCKY

We've been expecting you.

TOM

(mumbling quickly to self)
Expecting me? I must be going crazy. A nervous breakdown – yeah, that's it. Maybe it was something I ate. I knew I shouldn't have had that RedBull for breakfast.

SPONGE BOB

I can't hear you, it's too dark in here.

TOM

(flustered – clicking the remote)
This can't be real. I'm sorry guys but I must run! I have to teach my class.
Come on, Click. Teleport. Zap! Please remote!

ROCKY

Run. Teach. Click. Teleport. Zap. Do you realize those are all verbs? They all tell of an action.

SPONGE BOB

Well let's get this load of barnacles in action now!

- SCENE 3 - VERB! SONG -

1 Verb: That's What's Happening

MR MORTON

I get my thing in action (Verb!) To be, to sing, to feel, to live (Verb!)

(That's what's happenin')

ROCKY

I put my heart in action (**Verb!**) To run, to go, to get, to give (**Verb!**)

(You're what's happenin')

MR MORTON

That's where I find satisfaction, yeah! (**Yeah!**) To search, to find, to have, to hold (**Verb! To be bold**)

ROCKY

When I use my imagination (**Verb!**) I think, I plot, I plan, I dream Turning in towards creation (**Verb!**) I make, I write, I dance, I sing

BOTH

Cause I get my thing in action, Yeah, I get my thing in action! Lets Go!!!!

(explosion - guitar solo)

ROCKY

Hey! Hey! To be, to see, to feel the action! Hey! Hey! Gonna be, gonna see, gotta live the action!

(guitar solo)

When I'm feeling really active (**Verb!**) I run, I ride, I swim, I fly!

MR MORTON

Other times when life is easy I rest, I sleep, I sit, I lie.

ROCKY

I can take a noun and bend it,

Make it a verb and really send it!

Cause I get my thing in action,

And I don't even know my power!!!!

TOM: Verb! SPONGE BOB: Action!
TOM: Verb! SPONGE BOB: Action!
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TOM: Verb! SPONGE BOB: Action!

TOM: Verb! SPONGE BOB: Action!

ROCKY: On with the show let's start the action!

- SCENE 4 - JOKES OVER -

SPONGE BOB

Well, time to go make the crabbie patties. I'll remember you all in therapy.

Bye guys! Good luck Tom. (exits)

TOM

I must be losing my mind!

ROCKY

OMG! He's freaking out – bring me some water quick! (DORI brings him some water – he proceeds to drink it and hand the empty glass back) Whew!! I'm good.

TOM

Wait! Is there like a hidden camera somewhere? Am I being Punked? Come on out Ashton. Haha, very funny.

JANET

You're not being Punked Tom; you're being prepped. It's our job to get you ready properly for that first day of class. How well you teach will have a positive or negative effect on these children for the rest of their lives. We're here to help. Learning can be fun with a little imagination...

LUCKY

Enough with the nerves already...we've got a lot to teach you before that bell rings, so let's get that engine of yours in high gear... Come on Tom, move that machine!

- SCENE 5 - BODY MACHINE SONG -

2 Body Machine

LUCKY

When you look down the street, what do you see? The street is overflowing with a lot of machines. Now I don't mean the buses, the trucks or cars. I'm talking about the people, yeah, you know who They are.

LUCKY & TOM

I'm a machine, you're a machine.
Everybody that you know you know,
They are machines.
To keep your engine running you need energy
For your high-powered, revved-up body machine.
Your high-powered, revved-up body machine.

TOM

Now, I'd be a fool, if I said that the fuel that We needed to burn was gas, Because the fuel we use is the stuff called food, And it puts out the power for our machine.

You make a stop at the filling station,

JULIE

"Fill'er up! One chicken sandwich to go!"

TOM

As you start to chew, Your body does it.

TOM & LUCKY

All systems go!

(VALERIE & REGINA come out in sandwich costumes – ROCKY crosses to them)

ROCKY

(Spoken)

Now that sandwich contains some very important kinds of food energy for your body. The ham gives you protein; bread, carbohydrates; mayonnaise, fat; and the lettuce has vitamins, plus cellulose (or roughage). Together these things help keep your body machine running smoothly.

(PEARL becomes the "Body Machine."

Everyone uses cartoon drawings to illustrate what is happening inside of HER)

LUCKY

First the saliva, kind of like a driver

(GERALDINE is wearing a bus driver hat with a name plate that says "SALIVA")

GERALDINE "MOVE TO THE REAR OF THE MOUTH!"

LUCKY

But what it's doing, along with teeth chewing, Is taking food and breaking it down.

(MARY JEAN demonstrates the esophagus on PEARL)

Down to the stomach, the food is pushed, The esophagus does it's stuff, And the stomach starts,

(ROCKY demonstrates the stomach on PEARL)

TOM

Look at those moving parts!

LUCKY

As the body machine churns up.

TOM

Gastric juices operate on proteins, Fats and carbohydrates.

LUCKY

In the stomach they do what they do. They take out the nutrition and use it for you.

(RAFAELLA returns with white gloves and a policeman's hat that has a name plate with the word, "CELLULOSE" on it. SHE stands behind PEARL to control the 'flow')

TOM

And the cellulose, in those leaves you know, Will control the traffic flow. Helps the food to move along so the good stays in And the bad gets gone!

(RAFAELLA points and PEARL runs to the bathroom.)

TOM & LUCKY

I'm a machine, you're a machine.
Everybody that you know you know,
They are machines.
To keep your engine running you need energy
For your high-powered, revved-up body machine.
Your high-powered, revved-up body machine.

(PEARL has returned RAFAELLA now uses illustrations to demonstrate digestion on PEARL)

LUCKY

Then the small intestine Does most of your digesting, By sending all the nutrients

In through the villi,

TOM

Which look a little silli,

LUCKY

But act as little vents
The blood stream passes; the nutrients it catches
And takes them to the cells you see,
You use what it delivers,

TOM

And it stores some in the liver

LUCKY

For future energy.

LUCKY & TOM

I'm a machine, you're a machine.
Everybody that you know you know,
They are machines.
To keep your engine running you need energy
For your high-powered, revved-up body machine.
Your high-powered, revved-up body machine.

TOM

Your high-powered, revved-up, complicated tune-up,

TOM & LUCKY

Fascinating body machine

ROCKY

(To PEARL)

Take care of that machine. You got such a great model there, honey!

TOM

Give it the right fuel High protein, low calorie.

TOM & LUCKY

Take it out for a spin every day!

- SCENE 6 - CATCHING ON -

TOM

That was interesting, and kind of gross. I never thought about our body as actually being a machine but that really makes a lot of sense. I see what you mean now about using my imagination while teaching to keep the students interested.

REGINA

I'm sorry. What were you saying?

TOM

Come on, surely I'm not that boring. I think I'm catching on rather quickly, especially considering everything that was going on during that last song.

(walks up to Morticia – holds hand out) Oh, hello. What's your name? (blackout – red spotlight – sound effect) (Rocky grabs Tom's hand)

ROCKY

Um, yeah. About her. She showed up while the guys and I were watching horror-fest last month on AMC....and she never left.

MORTICIA (pre-recorded)

I'm Morticia. Glad to meet you Tom. Baby's hungry. (deep menacing laugh)

MOLLY

Yeah, far out! She is crazy man – crazy....

DINA

Crazy? Oh, I don't know if I'd call her crazy. I'm just not sure if she's a person or a thing in this place.

JULIE

Person...Place...Thing? That reminds me of another song.

- Scene 7 - Noun Song -

#3 Noun

JULIE

WELL, EVERY PERSON YOU CAN KNOW, AND EVERY PLACE THAT YOU CAN GO, AND EVERY THING THAT YOU CAN SHOW, YOU KNOW THEY'RE NOUNS.

A NOUN'S A SPECIAL KIND OF WORD, IT'S ANY NAME YOU EVER HEARD. I FIND IT QUITE INTERESTING. A NOUN'S A PERSON, PLACE OR THING.

OH, I TOOK A TRAIN, TOOK A TRAIN TO ANOTHER STATE.

So Tom, tell me. What made you want to become a teacher?

TOM

Well, my grandmother was a teacher. And her mother before her.

FRANKLIN

Your parents must have told you plenty of stories of your grandmother and great-grandmother for you to want to become a teacher too.

TOM

Yes. They were all very proud to be teachers. In fact, it was one of the few opportunities available to women at the time.

MARY JEAN

Back then, Tom, a woman didn't even have the right to vote.

TOM

You know, you are absolutely right.

MARY JEAN

This country was founded by men at a time when women had virtually no say about what went on in the world around them. They were left at home to cook and to clean... With the men telling them what to cook and what to clean...

- SCENE 9 - SUFFRAGE SONG -

4 Sufferin' Till Suffrage

FEMALE ENSEMBLE

WOO!

GERALDINE

NOW, YOU HAVE HEARD OF WOMEN'S RIGHTS, AND HOW WE'VE TRIED TO REACH NEW HEIGHTS. IF WE'RE "ALL CREATED EQUAL"... THAT'S US, TOO!

FEMALE ENSEMBLE

YEAH!

GERALDINE

BUT YOU WILL PROB-

FEMALE ENSEMBLE

BAH, BOP!

GERALDINE

-'BLY NOT RECALL THAT IT'S NOT BEEN

FEMALE ENSEMBLE

SHOOP, SHOO!

GERALDINE

TOO LONG AT ALL SINCE WE EVEN HAD THE RIGHT TO-CAST A VOTE.

FEMALE ENSEMBLE

YEAH!

GERALDINE

WELL, SURE, SOME MEN BOWED DOWN AND CALLED US "MISSUS",

FEMALE ENSEMBLE

YEAH!

GERALDINE

LET US HANG THE WASH OUT AND WASH THE DISHES.

FEMALE ENSEMBLE

GERALDINE

THEN THE NINETEENTH AMENDMENT STRUCK DOWN THAT RESTRICTIVE RULE.

FEMALE ENSEMBLE

OH YEAH!

BOP!

GERALDINE

AND NOW WE PULL DOWN

FEMALE ENSEMBLE

BAH!

GERALDINE

ON THE LEVER,

FEMALE ENSEMBLE

BOP!

GERALDINE

CAST OUR BALLOTS,

FEMALE ENSEMBLE

BAH!

GERALDINE

FEMALE ENSEMBLE

AND WE ENDEAVOR TO IM-PROVE OUR COUNTRY, STATE, COUNTY, TOWN AND SCHOOL.

TOM

It's 6 a.m. I have no spark.

MR MORTON

(in white lab coat)

I believe what she is referring to is sensory association.

In the cognitive science literature, if a melodic sequence brings about conscious awareness of a specific episode that you are being influenced by any specific past events then you would be experiencing explicit emotional memory for music.

EVERYONE

(very confused) Huh???

LUCKY

You know! It's like when you get that song stuck in your head, and it plays over and over....and over....and you just don't know why.

TOM

OK then...Um, Morton. What's with the lab coat. Are you in the process of inventing something?

MR MORTON

Yes, the segway to our next song.

GABRIELLA

The mothers depicted in this song do not necessarily reflect true historical happening. And events may have been changed for the story line. Only the inventors & inventions are real...

- Scene 11 - Mother Necessity Song -

#5 Mother Necessity

ALL

MOTHER NECESSITY, WITH HER GOOD INTENTIONS-WHERE WOULD THIS COUNTRY BE WITHOUT HER INVENTIONS?

GERALDO

Oh,
Things were rotten
In the land of cotton
Until Whitney made the cotton gin.
Now, old times there will
Soon be forgotten,
For it did the work of a hundred men.

ALL

MOTHER NECESSITY, WHERE WOULD WE BE?

RAFAELLA

Mother Edison worked late each night. It went well until the fading light.

MR MORTON

Little Thomas Alva Edison said,
"I'll grow up to be a great inventor
And I'll make a lamp
To help my mommy see." Wowee!
What an excellent application of electricity.

RAFAELLA

He worked hard to pull the switch. He was smart and very rich.

ALL

MOTHER NECESSITY HELPED US TO SEE.

FRANKLIN

Now, the mother of Samuel Morse Always sent the lad out on a horse.

DINA

Take a message to Ms. Peavy
On the far side of the pike.
Spread the word about the quilting bee
Next Saturday night.

FRANKLIN

Little Samuel started thinkin'
'bout a way to send a message
'cause he never met a horse he didn't like.

Ugh!

ALL

MOTHER NECESSITY...

RAFAELLA

Elias, Can You Help Me With My Sewing?

GERALDO

Mother, dear, I'll fulfill your fondest wishes.

RAFAELLA

Elias, how?

GERALDO

This machine I've made will Keep your sewing really flowing. In fact, it'll keep the whole nation in stitches.

ALL

Ahh...

MOTHER NECESSITY, WHERE WOULD WE BE?

FRANKLIN

Ring me on the Alexander Graham Bell. Thank you Alexander, for the phone.

I'd never get a date, I'd never get a job-Unless I had a telephone.

ALL

MOTHER NECESSITY...

GERALDINE

Orville, Wilbur, go outside this minute
And there continue with your silly playing.
Take these plans, take these blueprints,
Take this funny lookin thing.
Take that wheel and take that wing.
I can't hear a thing that Mrs. Johnson's saying.
Orville! Wilbur! Come back boys! Orville! Wilbur!

ALL

MOTHER NECESSITY, WHERE WOULD WE BE?

DINA

When Robert Fulton made the steamboat go...

FRANKLIN

When Marconi gave us wireless radio...

GERALDO

When Henry Ford cranked up his automo...

FRANKLIN

When Samuel Slater showed us how the factories go...

RAFAELLA

And all the iron and oil and coal and steel And "Yankee don't you know", They made this country really...

ALL

GROW, GROW, GROW, GRO-OW...

WITH MOTHER NECESSITY!
WHERE WOULD WE BE
WITHOUT THE INVENTIONS OF YOUR PROGENY?

- SCENE 12 - A REAL PAGE TURNER -

ROCKY

Where would we be today without all those inventions?.

REGINA

Nowhere! I'm sure glad they invented the TV otherwise we wouldn't exist.

PEARL

I think that *she* is probably right. But then again, if *they* had not invented TV, *Maybe we* would have been a book instead.

Ooohhh. What if we could have been the book Twilight? I would have been Bella...

MORTON

Yeah....and would have been Eddie!

PEARL

(frustrated) In your dreams! And by the way it's Edward, not Eddie. Uggghhh!!!!

REGINA

Us, a book? That's a novel idea.

LUCKY

Oh, brother. Hey! Do you realize how many pronouns we just used?

TOM

Yep! And I'm gonna use a few more! Rufus, come help me out.

- SCENE 13 - RUFUS SONG -

6 Rufus Xavier Sasperilla

TOM

Now, I have a friend named Rufus Xavier Sarsaparilla, And I could say that

Rufus found a kangaroo That followed Rufus home And now that kangaroo Belongs to Rufus Xavier Sarsaparilla. Whew!

I could say that, but I don't have to, 'cause I've got pronouns.
I can say-

He found a kangaroo
That followed him home
And now it is his.
You see-uh,
"he", "him" and "his" are pronouns
Replacing the noun
"Rufus Xavier Sarsaparilla"
(a very proper noun),
And "it" is a pronoun
Replacing the noun "kangaroo"!

Now, Rufus has a sister
Named Rafaella Gabriella Sarsparilla.
If she found a kangaroo
I could say to you:
She found a kangaroo
That followed her home and now it is hers,
But I can't say that...

'cause she found an aardvark That fell in love with her And they're so happy.

Now, my name's Albert Andreas Armadillo, No relation to the Sarsaparillas. Because of pronouns, I can say, "I wish she would find A rhinoceros for me, And we'd be happy." You see, a

Pronoun was made To take the place of a noun, 'cause sayin' all those nouns over and over Can really wear you down!

Now, I could tell you Rafaella Gabriella
And Rufus Xavier Sarsaparilla and
Albert Andreas Armadillo
Found an aardvark, a kangaroo, and a rhinoceros,
And now that aardvark, that kangaroo, and that
Rhinoceros
Belong respectively to
Rafaella Gabriella Sarsaparilla
And Rufus Xavier Sarsaparilla
And Albert Andreas Armadillo.
Whew!
Because of pronouns, I can say
In this way,

"we found them and they found us And now they are ours And we're so happy." Thank you, pronouns!

You see, a pronoun was made To take the place of a noun, 'cause sayin' all those nouns over and over Can really wear you down!

One more verse!

Sometimes when we take them all on the bus, People really raise a fuss.
They start shoutin' out a lot of pronouns at us Like.
"who brought that rhinoceros on the bus?"
And

"what made that horrible noise?" And...

"which one of 'em's getting' off first?"
Who, what, and which are special pronouns
That can ask a question in a sentence
When you do not know the name of the noun.
But I know I have mine

And she has hers,

He has his-

Do you have yours?
They love us and we love them.
What's ours is theirs,
That's how it is with friends.
And pronouns, you are really friends...
Yeah...
'cause sayin' all those nouns over and over
Can really wear you down!

- Scene 14 - After All, We're Only Hummin' -

TOM

Whew! That one wore me out. It was always one of my favorites when I was growing up.

JANET

Oh wow! You watched us when you were just a kid?

TOM

Of course! All of my friends did. In fact it was because of you that I passed my exam on the Constitution?

FRANKLIN

We did? Well good for us...I mean good for you....I mean...aww, good grief.

TOM

Yes. A classroom full of students all humming the same tune.

- Scene 15 - Preamble Song -

#7 Preamble

ENSEMBLE

HEY, DO YOU KNOW ABOUT THE U.S.A.? DO YOU KNOW ABOUT THE GOVERNMENT? CAN YOU TELL ME 'BOUT THE CONSTITUTION? HEY, LEARN ABOUT THE U.S.A!

PEARL

In 1787, I'm told, Our founding fathers did agree To write a list of principles For keepin' people free.

The U.S.A. was just starting out, A whole brand new country, And so our people spelled it out, The things that we should be.

PEARL

And they put those principles down on paper and called it the Constitution. And it's been helping us run our country ever since then. The first part of the Constitution is called the "Preamble" and tells what those founding fathers set out to do.

ALL

WE THE PEOPLE,
IN ORDER TO FORM A MORE PERFECT UNION,
ESTABLISH JUSTICE, INSURE DOMESTIC TRANQUILLITY,
PROVIDE FOR THE COMMON DEFENSE,
PROMOTE THE GENERAL WELFARE AND
SECURE THE BLESSINGS OF LIBERTY
TO OURSELVES AND OUR POSTERITY,
DO ORDAIN AND ESTABLISH
THIS CONSTITUTION
FOR THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA.

DINA

In 1787,I'm told,
Our founding fathers all sat down

That's known the world around.

The U.S.A. was just starting out, A whole brand new country, And so our people spelled it out: They wanted a land of liberty.

TOM

So Pearl, how does the Preamble go?

PEARL

I'm glad ya asked, Tom.

ALL

WE THE PEOPLE,
IN ORDER TO FORM A MORE PERFECT UNION,
ESTABLISH JUSTICE, INSURE DOMESTIC TRANQUILITY,
PROVIDE FOR THE COMMON DEFENSE,
PROMOTE THE GENERAL WELFARE AND
SECURE THE BLESSINGS OF LIBERTY
TO OURSELVES AND OUR POSTERITY,
DO ORDAIN AND ESTABLISH
THIS CONSTITUTION
FOR THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA.

- Scene 16 - Hummingbird is on the Fly -

ROCKY (hand to ear)

Hummingbird is on the fly. Repeat, Hummingbird is on the fly.

TOM

Hummingbird? What? What are you...

(GERALDO & REGINA as secret service enter and frisk Tom)

What is going on here?!?

ROCKY

The nest is clear. Repeat, the nest is clear. Sorry Tom but we always have to take precautions when the President arrives.

TOM

The President!?!? Donald Trump is still here??

FRANKLIN

A friend of ours has an appointment with him. I hope it goes well. Here he comes now. Hey, Bill. Are you nervous?

BILL

Aww....I'm sweatin' ink. I don't know if I can do this.

- Scene 17 - I'M Just A Bill Song -

#8 I'm Just A Bill

ZERO

You sure gotta climb a lot of steps to get to this Capitol Building here in Washington.

But I wonder who that sad little scrap of paper is?

BILL

I'm just a bill.
Yes, I'm only a bill.
And I'm sitting here on Capitol Hill.
Well, it's a long, long journey
To the capital city.

It's a long, long wait
While I'm sitting in committee,
But I know I'll be a law someday
At least I hope and pray that I will,
But today I am still just a bill.

ZERO

Gee, Bill, you certainly have a lot of patience and courage.

BILL

Yeah. And when I started out, I wasn't even a bill. I was just an idea.

Some folks back home decided they wanted a law passed, so they called their local Congressman and he said:

ROCKY

"You're right! There ought to be a law."

BILL

Then he sat down, wrote me out, and introduced me to Congress, and I became a bill. And I'll remain a bill until they decide to make me a law.

I'm just a bill
Yes I'm only a bill,
And I got as far as Capitol Hill.
Well, now I'm stuck in committee
And I'll sit here and wait
While a few key Congressmen discuss and debate
Whether they should let me be a law.
How I hope and pray that they will,
But today I am still just a bill.

ZERO

Listen to all those Congressmen arguing! Is all that discussion and debate about you?

BILL

Yeah, and I'm one of the lucky ones.

Most bills never even get this far. I hope they decide to report on me favorably.

Otherwise I may die.

ZERO

Die?

BILL

Yeah, die in committee.

Oh, but it looks like I'm gonna live! Now, I go to the House of Representatives and they vote on me.

ZERO

What happens if they say "yes"?

BILL

Then I go to the Senate and the whole thing starts all over again!

ZERO

Oh no!

BILL

Oh, yes!

I'm just a bill
Yes, I'm only a bill
And if they vote for me on Capitol Hill
Well, then I'm off to the White House
Where I'll wait in a line
With a lot of other bills
For the president to sign
And if he signs me, then I'll be a law.
How I hope and pray that he will,
But today I am still just a bill.

ZERO

Wait...You mean even if the whole Congress says you should be a law, the President can still say "no"?

BILL

Yes, that's called a...

ENSEMBLE

Veto!

BILL

If the President...

ENSEMBLE

Vetoes!

BILL

...me, then I have to go back to the Congress and they vote on me again.

But by that time...

ZERO

By that time it's very unlikely that you'll become a law. It's not easy to become a law is it?

BILL

No, it isn't...

But how I hope and I pray that I will, But today I am still just a bill.

REGINA

He signed ya, Bill. Now you're a law!

BILL OH, YEAH!

- SCENE 18 - THE TAX MAN COMETH -

FRANKLIN

Bill was sure glad to finally see the president.

REGINA

Well yeah. Everyone wants to meet the President.

GERALDINE

That would be exciting. But there are some government people that you dread seeing.

FRANKLIN

Geraldine, what did you do this time? Are you going to be on Judge Judy again? I told you not to post that video on YouTube!

GERALDINE

No! I didn't do anything wrong.....this time. I'm talking about the Tax Man.

MAX

Somebody call?

- SCENE 19 - TAX MAN MAX SONG -

9 Tax Man Max

MAX

Welcome to the new variety. Sit and relax. I'm that song and dance phenomenon, max! Let me sing for you,
Do my thing for you,
'til they give me the axe.
Here's the song I'm doin'
Gonna fill you in on tax!

Tax is that familiar melody simple and true.
Hum it if you've earned a dollar or two
Bucks are bein' spent
By the government
For whatever they do.
Everyone that earns a livin' gives more than a few.

So our schools can be their best. So our roads will have no cracks. Someone fix those train tracks. I hear you callin' uncle And I'm payin' my tax.

(MARY JEAN, PEARL, JANET & GABRIELLA enter with tap shoes on & each wearing "Las Vegas style" outfits).

MAX

(Spoken)
Oh, these are my girls! Hello, girls!

WOMEN

Hello, Max!

PEARL

Nice outfit.

WOMEN

There are many different ways That we pay what we owe

MAX

Ladies if you'll form a lovely tableau.

MARY JEAN

Income!

GABRIELLA

Property!

JANET

Sales!

PEARL

Utility!

MAX

Candy bars at my show!

WOMEN

Oh!

Licenses for dogs and cats...

MAX

And that's not all, you know. Out of almost every dollar a person can make City, state and federal governments take

GABRIELLA

Take what?!

MAX

What they think is fair, You give in your share. Now and then there's a break. Max is talkin' taxes--hey! Have i kept you awake!?

WOMEN

For the things your town may need... For the things the country lacks... All good things take green backs.

WOMEN & MAX

We hear you callin' uncle And we're payin' our tax!

(WOMEN get picket signs that say, "DOWN WITH TAXES", "UNFAIR, " and 'NO TAXES.)

WOMEN

People do complain, Say their taxes are high. What am I to get in return?

MAX

Look around you friend. Max is showing you why?

WOMEN

With your taxes you support How we live and how we learn.

(MARY JEAN & PEARL turn THEIR picket signs around to show a picture of a house and a library)

MAX

(Spoken)

Now, here's the good news...many things are tax deductible. Which means their cost can be subtracted from the amount of income you'll be taxed on. Things like...

(JANET turns her picket sign around to reveal pictures of medicine, doctor bills and office supplies)

...Medicine, doctor bills and supplies for your work.
So keep those receipts!

(Tap dance)

Be kind to your parents at tax time...

(Tap dance)

MAX

And remember...April fifteenth.

(GABRIELLA turns her picket sign around to reveal the words, "APRIL 15")

WOMEN

April fifteenth.
What a show man you are max.
Entertaining us with tax
In those snazzy plaid slacks!

TOM

These slacks are for my business.

(Tap dance)

I tell you I'll deduct 'em.

(Tap dance)

I hear you callin' uncle And I'm payin my tax!

WOMEN

His tax! Our max!

(MAX removes his belt which makes his pants drop to reveal boxer shorts that have large dollar signs (\$) all over them.)

MAX

And I'm deducting my slacks!

WOMEN

Oh--yeah!

END OF ACT 1

- SCENE 20 - RELAXING WITH BELLA & EDDIE -

The act opens with the Teacher sitting in a recliner, eating popcorn while watching a scene from "Twilight" which is being reenacted by Mr. Morton & Pearl. The lights are dim as if he were watching this at home one evening.

PEARL as BELLA

You're impossibly fast. And strong.
Your skin is pale-white, ice-cold.
Your eyes change color. And
sometimes you speak like... you're
from a different time.

(turns to face him now)

You never eat food, or drink, or come out in the sunlight. And you said no to the beach trip only after you heard where it was.

How old are you?

MORTON as EDWARD

Seventeen.

BELLA

How long have you been seventeen?

EDWARD

... A while.

BELLA

I know what the Cold Ones are. What you are.

EDWARD

Say it. Out loud. Say it.

BELLA

... Vampire

EDWARD

Are you afraid?

BELLA

No. You won't hurt me. You're different.

EDWARD

You think you know me?

(He glares at her. She holds her ground. Suddenly, he takes her by the hand. Starts walking.)

BELLA

Where are we going?

(Rocky enters unseen by all.)

EDWARD

Up the mountain. Out of the fog. Hold on. You need to see what I really am. What I look like in the harsh light of the sun.

(Then he flings her onto his back... and starts running. Images fly by on the projector of the forest, the city, the ocean, space...)

Bella finds herself sitting on the ground. All is silent. Then she realizes she's alone.

BELLA

Edward? Where are you?

(EDWARD is standing in the shadows.)

EDWARD

This is why we don't show ourselves in sunlight..

(Finally, he takes a deep breath, and steps out of the shade. He is wearing a Michael Jackson jacket & wig that infuriates Pearl.)

PEARL

Eddie....Edward! Ugghh. Morton!!!! You're impossible!

ROCKY

What is going on??? What are you two doing?.

TOM

I was flipping channels, hoping to relax a few minutes when Bella and Edward, I mean Morton and Pearl asked if I wanted to watch the vampire movie "Twilight".

ROCKY

Well, how was it?

TOM

It bit.

PEARL

UUGGHH! Well fine then! Come on Edward!

MORTON

That's Eddie. (receives a stern look from Pearl) Yes dear, I'm coming.

ROCKY

If you wanted something relaxing to watch, why not choose one of my favorites? Who knows - you might actually learn something while you chill in the snow.

TOM

The snow?
(The lights dim, fog billows and snow begins to fall.
Dancer enters as figure skating ballerina.)

- SCENE 21 - FIGURE EIGHT SONG-

#10 Figure Eight

JANET

FIGURE EIGHT AS DOUBLE FOUR

GABRIELLA

FIGURE FOUR AS HALF OF EIGHT;

JANET

IF YOU SKATE, YOU WOULD BE GREAT,

GABRIELLA

IF YOU COULD MAKE A FIGURE EIGHT.

BOTH

THAT'S A CIRCLE THAT TURNS 'ROUND UPON ITSELF.

GABRIELLA

ONE TIMES EIGHT IS TWO TIMES FOUR, FOUR TIMES FOUR IS TWO TIMES EIGHT.

JANET

IF YOU SKATE UPON THIN ICE, YOU'D BE WISE IF YOU THOUGHT TWICE BEFORE YOU MADE ANOTHER SINGLE MOVE!

BOTH

ONE TIMES EIGHT IS EIGHT.
TWO TIMES EIGHT IS SIXTEEN,
THREE TIMES EIGHT IS TWENTY-FOUR,
FOUR TIMES EIGHT IS THIRTY-TWO,
AND FIVE TIMES EIGHT IS FORTY, YOU KNOW.

SIX TIMES EIGHT IS FORTY-EIGHT.
SEVEN TIMES EIGHT IS FIFTY-SIX,
EIGHT TIMES EIGHT IS SIXTY-FOUR,
NINE TIMES EIGHT IS SEVENTY-TWO,
AND TEN TIMES EIGHT IS EIGHTY, THAT'S TRUE.

GABRIELLA

ELEVEN TIMES EIGHT IS EIGHTY-EIGHT, AND TWELVE TIMES EIGHT IS NINETY-SIX.

JANET

NOW HERE'S A CHANCE TO GET OFF ON YOUR NEW MATH TRICKS, 'CAUSE TWELVE TIMES EIGHT IS THE SAME AS TEN TIMES EIGHT PLUS TWO TIMES EIGHT.

BOTH

EIGHTY PLUS SIXTEEN... NINETY SIX!

ONE TIMES EIGHT IS EIGHT.
TWO TIMES EIGHT IS SIXTEEN,
THREE TIMES EIGHT IS TWENTY-FOUR,
FOUR TIMES EIGHT IS THIRTY-TWO,
AND FIVE TIMES EIGHT IS FORTY, YOU KNOW.

JANET

FIGURE EIGHT AS DOUBLE FOUR, FIGURE FOUR AS HALF OF EIGHT;

GABRIELLA

IF YOU SKATE, YOU WOULD BE GREAT, IF YOU COULD MAKE A FIGURE EIGHT.

BOTH

THAT'S A CIRCLE THAT TURNS 'ROUND UPON ITSELF. PLACE IT ON ITS SIDE AND IT'S A SYMBOL MEANING... INFINITY.

- Scene 22 - Unlucky Lucky -

(Morton, Pearl, Tom & Rocky return joined by Geraldo & Franklin)

TOM

Thanks Rocky. That was beautiful, relaxing and educational.

ROCKY

(gestures towards Pearl who shrugs him off and crosses her arms)

See. And no one was bit in the process.

(Lucky enters pretending to be a ballerina. Half way across stage he falls and pretends to have broken his leg.)

LUCKY

Oh!!!! My leg!

TOM

Lucky, are you alright?

LUCKY

No. My leg hurts really badly. It may be broken.

ROCKY

Maybe you should leave the dancing to the professionals. Here, lets take a look at Them Bones.

(Lucky is laid back on the upper stage with his side to the audience. Nurses attend to him. Geraldine slips in beside him away from audience view, wearing the skeleton outfit.)

- Scene 23 - Them Bones Song -

#11 Them Bones

MALE ENSEMBLE

THEM BONES, THEM BONES, THEM DRY BONES, NOW THEYRE THE WORKING OF THE LORD.

BONES ARE HEARD OF, BUT SELDOM SEEN, 'CEPT EACH YEAR 'ROUND HALLOWEEN.

TOM

BUT I'VE GOT A...

ALL

SHOCKEROO,

TOM

RIGHT NOW THERE'S A SKELETON LOCKED UP NSIDE OF YOU

(Geraldine rises from where Lucky was laying dressed in Skeleton outfit)

(HA-HA-HA)

FRANKLIN

(Rocky & Tom help Lucky to his feet. Lucky is wobbly from having no bones)

MINUS BONES YOU'RE JUST A BLOB,

BEING FRAMEWORK'S THEIR MAIN JOB. ALL YOUR ORGANS, MUSCLES, TOO,

ALL

THEY NEED YOUR BONES TO HOLD THEM SAFE AND SOUND INSIDE FOR YOU

LUCKY

YOUR HEART AND LUNGS ARE TUCKED AWAY, IN THERE BEHIND YOUR RIBS THOSE BONES HAVE BEEN PROTECTING THEM, SINCE WE WERE LITTLE KIDS

(Rocky gets a large 'femur" and uses it as a baseball bat. TOM uses a skull as a baseball. He pitches the ball to ROCKY in slow motion.)

MR MORTON

LOOKOUT, HERE COMES A BONEHEAD PLAY!

(LUCKY carries the ball across stage as if in slow motion and strikes Rocky in the head with it.)

BIRDIN' HIS BRAIN, (TWEET, TWEET, TWEET)

ROCKY

(Rubbing his head)
WHAT A DAY!
DON'T TAKE MUCH TO OVERWHELM IT,

(Standing back up)

BUT LUCKILY THOSE BONES UP THERE WORK LIKE A BUILT-IN HELMET!

ALL

SHIN BONE CONNECTED TO THE KNEE BONE

GERALDO

(THAT MEANS THE TIBIA CONNECTS TO THE PATELLA)

ALL

KNEE BONE CONNECTED TO THE THIGH BONE

FRANKLIN

(THAT MEANS THE PATELIA CONNECTS TO THE FEMUR)

TOM

AND HERE'S HOW THEY REALLY FIT TOGETHER.

(A Secondary brings out a diagram of the knee joint)

LIGAMENTS ARE WHAT LINK BONE TO BONE. CARTILAGE THAT CUSHIONS IN BETWEEN. MUSCLES HOOK ON, BY THE TENDONS,

ROCKY

(TOM and LUCKY demonstrate with deep knee bends.) SO HERE'S WHAT'S HAPPENIN' IN YOUR KNEES MOST EV'RY TIME YOU BEND 'EM.

(Dentist group appear from offstage)

LUCKY

NOW THERE'S A LOT OF SKELETON
WE NEVER GET TO SEE,
BUT IT HOLDS OTHER LITTLE PARTS
THAT SHOW QUITE OBVIOUSLY.
I'M TALKIN' 'BOUT THOSE THIRTY-TWO
THAT WE ALL CALL OUR TEETH.
WE GOTTA FEED 'EM RIGHT AND KEEP 'EM CLEAN,
OR THEY CAN COME TO GRIEF.

(Mary Jean uses the tongs and pretends to pull one of Franklin's teeth out)

OUCH!

GERALDO

SO PLEASE REMEMBER, YOU GOT TO DO IT WHILE YOU'RE YOUNG

MR MORTON

FEED YOUR BONES SOME GOOD OLD CALCIUM

ROCKY

DRINKING MILK--A GLASS OR TWO-

ALL

WILL HELP YOUR BONES STAY IN SHAPE AND DO THEIR JOB FOR YOU.

(The side skeletons and Geraldine sneak up on Morton and the females who seem scared.

They all scream when the skeletons leap out at them. Morton jumps into Pearl's arms)

ALL

YOUR SKELETON...

TOM

IT'S A FRAMEWORK, (YES, YES) HOLDING YOU TOGETHER.

ALL

YOUR SKELETON...

FRANKLIN

SHIELDING ORGANS,

ROCKY

YEA, THAT'S ITS JOB, TOO!

ALL

YOUR SKELETON!

- SCENE 24 - GETTING THE MESSAGE-

DINA

Looks like nothing is broken. You'll be OK.

LUCKY

I think you're right. Why does it still hurt though?

REBECCA

That's your leg sending messages to your brain to let it know that something is wrong.

LUCKY

(starts swatting at a fly)
Messages? What are you taking about?

ZERO

Whenever you get hurt your body tells your brain about it so that it can see what is wrong.

REGINA

Yeah. If you touch something hot your nervous system tells your brain, which then tells your hand to quit touching it.

VALERIE

It's like a telegraph system for your body. Get the message?

LUCKY

(still after the fly) Not really.

REBECCA

Boys! I think their message system is slower than ours. I know! See if this helps you understand how it works.

- SCENE 25 - TELEGRAPH LINE SONG -

#12 Telegraph Line

FRANKLIN

THERE'S A TELEGRAM FOR YOU MA'AM, AND THE MESSAGE IS CLEAR. IT SAYS THERE'S SOMETHING BUGGING YOU AND BUZZING IN YOUR EAR. THE RESULTS CAN BE QUITE ITCHY SO WHAT IS YOUR REPLY?

(ZERO hands LUCKY the fly swatter)

TELL YOUR ARM TO SWAT THAT FLY!

(During the chorus, EVERYONE passes a large telegram envelope from one person to the next.)

GIRL ENSEMBLE (Dina, Rebecca, Janet, Valerie, Regina)

HEY, THERE'S A TELEGRAPH LINE,
YOU GOT YOURS AND I GOT MINE.
IT'S CALLED THE NERVOUS SYSTEM,
AND EVERYBODY UNDERSTANDS
THOSE TELEGRAM COMMANDS
AND YOU KNOW THAT EVERYBODY BETTER LISTEN!

ZERO

THE CENTRAL NERVOUS SYSTEM IS THE BRAIN AND THE SPINE THE BRAIN CONTROLS THE SYSTEM AND THE SPINE IS THE LINE

(TOM uses a small cut-out of a lightning bolt--like the cartoon—to demonstrate an idea coming into LUCKY's brain and passing down her arm to his hand.)

TELEGRAMS COME IN TO TELL WHAT'S HAPPENING TO YOU, THEN TELEGRAMS GO OUT TO TELL YOUR BODY WHAT TO DO.

JULIE

THERE'S A TELEGRAM FOR YOU SIR, BETTER READ IT ON THE SPOT. IT SAYS YOUR HAND IS NEAR A STOVE THAT'S VERY, VERY HOT. THE RESULTS CAN BE QUITE PAINFUL, AND THERE'S NO TIME TO THINK.

(JANET is cooking. GERALDO enters and wants to try some. JANET, wearing a mitt, hands the hot pot to GERALDO who holds back the pain as long as he can. He finally hands the pot back to Janet and runs screaming off stage. Janet tastes the contents and gives a wicked smile)

QUICK! PULL THAT HAND AWAY, AND GET IT TO THE SINK!

GIRL ENSEMBLE

THERE'S A TELEGRAPH LINE, YOU GOT YOURS AND I GOT MINE. IT'S CALLED THE NERVOUS SYSTEM, AND EVERYBODY UNDERSTANDS THOSE TELEGRAM COMMANDS AND YOU KNOW THAT EVERYBODY BETTER LISTEN!

(PEARL has entered with a flower)

REBECCA

YOUR PERIPHERAL NERVES, THEY GO ALL OUT, DELIVERING THOSE MESSAGES YOUR SENSES SEND OUT. FROM YOUR HEARING AND TOUCH TO YOUR SIGHT AND TASTE AND SMELL,

(RAFAELLA takes a big whiff of the flower PEARL holds. TOM uses the cutout lightning bolt again to demonstrate the smell going into her nose and how her brain reacts.)

THEY LET YOUR BRAIN REACT TO ALL THE MESSAGES THEY TELL.

FRANKLIN

(To MORTON)
THERE'S A TELEGRAM FOR YOU, KID,
THAT GIRL'S GIVIN' YOU THE EYE.
SHE THINKS SOMETHING HERE IS SWEET
AND I SURE DON'T MEAN THE PIE.

(PEARL gives MORTON the flower.)

YOU'RE A LITTLE BIT EMBARRASSED.

BECAUSE YOU'VE GOT A CRUSH.
YOUR HEART STARTS BEATIN' FASTER AND YOU BLUSH!

GIRL ENSEMBLE

HEY, THERE'S A TELEGRAPH LINE, YOU GOT YOURS AND I GOT MINE. IT'S CALLED THE NERVOUS SYSTEM, AND EVERYBODY UNDERSTANDS THOSE TELEGRAM COMMANDS AND YOU KNOW THAT EVERYBODY BETTER LISTEN!

FRANKLIN & JULIE

THE AUTONOMIC SYSTEM HAS A HOLD OF YOU, CONTROLLING AUTOMATICALLY SOME THINGS THAT YOU DO

DINA

YOUR BREATHING AND YOUR HEARTBEAT JUST GO ON NATURALLY

(PEARL is flirting with MORTON. SHE reaches out and takes HIS hand. MORTON gets embarrassed and runs away from HER.)

ZERO

AND WHEN YOU'RE SCARED, YOUR NERVES REV UP THE SPEED!

GIRL ENSEMBLE

HEY, THERE'S A TELEGRAPH LINE, YOU GOT YOURS AND I GOT MINE. IT'S CALLED THE NERVOUS SYSTEM, AND EVERYBODY UNDERSTANDS THOSE TELEGRAM COMMANDS AND YOU KNOW THAT EVERYBODY BETTER LISTEN!

- Scene 26 - Down With It -

LUCKY

OK, thanks girls. I think I understand now. I guess you could say I'm down with it.

(An apple falls on his head, then another. Tom enters.)

Ouch!

TOM

Better not stand under that apple tree too long or gravity will be down with you.

(another apple falls but stops mid-air over Tom)

MARY JEAN

(in police outfit writing a ticket)
Alright, alright. Who's breaking the law here?

TOM

Breaking the law? What do you mean?

MARY JEAN

Newton's Law of Gravity

TOM

Newton? I think you are mistaken. He was the fig guy. These are apples.

MARY JEAN

Hmmm. Are you sure you are a teacher? I'm talking about Isaac Newton.

(turns to Lucky)

You wanna take this one or should I?

LUCKY

I got it. Thanks.

(the suspended apple falls the rest of the way and hits Tom)

TOM

Ouch!

LUCKY

THE SEA WOULD FLOAT AWAY, AND SO WOULD FIELDS AND TOWNS,

MALE ENSEMBLE

NOTHIN' PULLIN' US

LUCKY & MALE ENSEMBLE

DOWN, DOWN, DOWN, DOWN, YEAH. SIR ISAAC NEWTON-

LUCKY

UNDERNEATH THE APPLE TREE.

MALE ENSEMBLE

APPLE TREE, YEAH!

LUCKY

ONE HIT HIM ON THE HEAD. HE SAID, "THAT MUST BE GRAVITY."

ROCKY

Newton's law of gravity says that every object in the universe pulls on every other object. The bigger the object, the stronger the pull. But the greater the distance between the objects, the weaker the pull becomes.

"Come back, Mary Jean!"

LUCKY

DON'T CALL ME CLUMSY, DON'T CALL ME A FOOL. WHEN THINGS FALL DOWN ON ME, I'M FOLLOWING THE RULE-THE RULE THAT SAYS THAT WHAT GOES UP COMES DOWN, LIKE ME!

LUCKY & MALE ENSEMBLE

I'M A VICTIM OF DOWN, DOWN, DOWN, GRAVITY! SHOO-BE-DOO, DOWN, DOWN, DOWN.

- SCENE 28 - TOM HAS LEFT THE BUILDING -

GABRIELLA

Hey Tom, you're not a bad dancer.

TOM

(as Elvis)
Why thank ya. Thank ya very much!

Sorry. Couldn't resist with the fifties music and the leather jackets.

(takes off the leather jacket and tosses it off stage)

Don't worry Gabriella. No more king.

GABRIELLA

Oh, we haven't had a King for hundreds of years. We have a President now

TOM

No. I meant me acting as Elvis, the king of Rock...

GABRIELLA

Relax Tom. I was just teasing you. I knew what you meant.

TOM

You were right though, about the President. Back in the 1700s our brave, young nation fought hard to break away from the tyranny of the ruling King. Many died but we never gave up and eventually we won our freedom. We became a democracy and elected a President of the people.

Now over 200 years later our freedom and democracy lives on.

And the predicates the verb, that's the action word That gets the subject like, up and out.

Mr. Morton was very nervous. Yeah, Mr. Morton was.

(moves towards the TV screen)

Goodbye everyone and thanks again.

ALL

Bye...good luck...etc

(TOM presses the remote. Fog and strobes begin. Lights go out. Curtain closes. TOM reappears in his classroom on side-stage. The custodian is waiting.)

CUSTODIAN

Anything good on? I never watch these things myself.
Seems like there's hundreds of channels of nothing.
Occasionally though you come across something really worth while.

How about you? Did you find one of those channels for yourself?

TOM

I did indeed. (sincere) Thank you.

CUSTODIAN

(moving out. students enter classroom.)
Oh no need to thank me. Just doing my job.

It's up to me to keep this place running ya know.

Good luck, Tom. You'll do great.

(lights come up more as his students continue to enter. TOM picks up a study book from his desk and flips through it.)

TOM

Good morning class. I am your new teacher.

We'll get started today in chapter one of your history book.

(He pauses as he sees the students and then sets the book back onto his desk.

He picks up the special remote and as he does the light begins to blink once again.)

You know what? Put your books away...who's up for a field trip?

(TOM smiles and clicks the remote. The lights go out. Electricity begins)
